- ❖ Abstracts will be accepted for free communication sessions, however, Scientific Programme committee reserves the right to allocate abstract/s to either oral presentations or poster sessions.
- ❖ Acceptance/ non-acceptance of the abstract/s will be notified by 15th July 2016.
- ❖ All accepted abstracts would be published in an abstract book. Publication of the abstracts in the abstract book requires conference registration by at least one author prior to conference latest by 15th July, 2016.

## Instructions to Author(s)

1. Please follow the instructions given below:
  1. List the name of all the authors along with their affiliations. The family name of authors should be followed by their given name. Underline the presenting author's name. The email address of corresponding author should be mentioned clearly.
  2. The authors have to specify if they wish the submission to presented as:
    1. Poster presentation
    2. Oral presentation
    3. Poster or Oral presentation
  3. The scientific committee reserves the right to make the final decision concerning the form of presentation.
  4. Structure your abstract using the following subheadings
    - A. Studies
      - i. List of author(s)
      - ii. Introduction and Objectives
      - iii. Materials and Methods
      - iv. Results
      - v. Conclusions

- B. Case reports
    - a. Introduction
    - b. Case report
    - c. Discussion
    - d. Conclusion
2. Abstract must be typed, single spaced in English and a minimum type size of 12 points must be used.
3. Check spelling grammar carefully. Direct reproduction from your electronically submitted abstract text means that any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific data will be reproduced as submitted.
4. Failure to comply with the following requirements will lead to automatic rejection of the submission: Use generic names. The use of commercial drug names, brands and registered trademarks are strictly prohibited. Drugs should be referred to by the active substance or pharmacological designation.
5. Type the title in capital letters.
6. When using abbreviations, write the full form of abbreviations first and follow with the abbreviations in parenthesis. Do not use abbreviations in the title of the abstract.
7. Abstract should not be more than 250 words.
8. Time allotted for each presentation will be 8mins + 2 mins. (For guest speakers time will be 20+ minutes)
9. E Posters:

All posters accepted will be displayed in digital format only on monitors within the Poster Gallery. Poster authors will not need to prepare nor print out any paper-based posters for ICD 2016.



